## Chairman of State Administration Council Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing Inspected the Renovation of the Ordination Hall of the Sixth Synod Maha Pasana Cave



Chairman of the State Administration Council Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing, accompanied by Council members, Union Ministers, the region Chief Minister, the Commander of Yangon Command, the mayor and officials, inspected the renovation progress of the ordination hall of the Sixth Synod Maha Pasana Cave on Thirimingalar Kaba Aye Hillock in Yangon Region, on 31 October.

Union Minister for Religious Affairs and Culture U Ko Ko, and officials reported to the Senior General on a brief history of the cave and its damage with a passage of time and renovation tasks. Regarding the reports, the Senior General stressed the following points;

- It is necessary to renovate by doing systematic research as the cave is a religious landmark as well as a historic building.
- It is not for doing repair to superficial damage only but for renovating the cave in accord with modern methods and sustainable systems without harming the

ancient original works and it is also required to consider necessary designs and equipment in detail and systematic records must be made of the renovation tasks.

- In conducting repair works, Senior General highlighted that full renovation must be systematically carried out in stages to ensure the long-term endurance rather than the finance and time. Also the same, the significant and historic buildings of other religions must be renovated.

The Sixth Synod Maha Pasana Cave is located in Thiri Mingalar Kaba Aye Hillock in Mayangon Township. The cave construction was completed on 10 May 1954 and other Buddhist ceremonies have been also held there. As the 67-year-old cave sees damage, major renovation tasks are going on and 55 per cent has been completed.

After hearing the reports, the Senior General stressed the following points:

- The literary, motion picture, music and theatrical performer organizations maintain the good history. Those from the literary field and fine arts arena politically participated in the independence struggle.
- They not only politically participated in the independence struggle but also carried out development of the country depending on the policies of the government after the country had regained the independence.
- All artistes made motivation the entire people to be active and participate in the moves of respective eras. They persuaded the people into the situation of the State with entertainments in successive eras by preserving the Myanmar traditional culture and national characters.
- The histories proved the artists served the interests of the State depending on the demand of respective eras.
- The themes of literature, film, theatrical performer and musical industries are adopted for the sake of the nation.
- At present, the role of print media is down but the online media is up regarding the culture. Likewise, the role of film industry is down in the cultural sector while musical sector is also influenced by western music.
- To emerge a modern, developed democratic country, it is necessary to implement the good education system. As the educated persons will have higher knowledge and techniques, artists need to encourage the education sector for the development of the nation.

- The country faced crises in the outbreak of COVID-19 due to a lack of equipment, medicines and human resources. At present, the infection rate of COVID-19 is down. Artistes are urged to assist in the resumption of the State machinery hampered by the pandemic.
  - The government is implementing the road map and objectives in accord with the pledge of the Tatmadaw. After implementing the road map, the paving of the country will be strengthened.
  - The role of artists is important in the State-building and nation-building tasks. Encouragement and undertakings can be much carried out through the literary arena, and music can improve the mindset of the people as well as destroy the country.
  - Some committed wrongdoings out of emotion or under the influence of instigations, but the government forgave them and released the persons who faced legal punishment.
  - Acts of artistes must be beneficial to the people and must not be incited to harm the State. They all need to abide by the rules and regulations in the respective sectors.
  - Efforts are underway for the resurgence of the national economy that has been in a downturn since 2018. The country will reach the mid-level in ASEAN in four or five years if it can improve the infrastructure through education promotion activities and modern agricultural techniques. And within 10 years it can reach the top level.
  - The Senior General said that artistes from literary, film, theatrical performer and musical industries need to preserve the national culture and characteristics.
- The Chairman of the State Administration Council Prime Minister then presented a trust fund of K400 million, 100 bags of rice, 500 visses of cooking oil and 300 visses of a gram for literature, movie, stage drama and music fields to officials of respective arenas. After hearing the reports of relevant officials, the Senior General stressed the following points:

- It is necessary to manufacture a large number of oil tankers, water tank trucks, dump trucks, disinfectant trucks and fire engines because they are needed for not only Tatmadaw but also for urban development functions and fire prevention.
- Further researches are also required for manufacturing the high-tech vehicles meeting the international standards. The Senior General then inspected assembling process of automobiles and related materials using modern machinery and technology, and presented cash award to the employees.

It is reported that the heavy industry of the Tatmadaw in Mayangon township manufactures fire engines that can carry from 2,000 to 2,200 gallons of water, water tank trucks and fuel tank trucks, dump trucks, disinfectant trucks and other related parts such as jeep frames, and bolts and nuts.

## Coordination Meetings on Hotels and Tourism Sector Development Held in Mon and Kayin States

## COVID-19 Prevention, Control, and Treatment Activities Continue in Respective Regions and States



Receiving closed contacts at Nay Pyi Taw Interrogation and Accommodation centre

In every state and region of Myanmar, Tatmadaw and departmental officials are accelerating the COVID-19 prevention, control and treatment activities such as, opening Quarantine centres and vaccinating against COVID-19.

- A total of 105 closed contacts (46 males and 59 females) are taking necessary treatments at Nay Pyi Taw Interrogation and Accommodation centre.
- The vaccination processes continue in respective regions and states. As per the priority programme, a total of 81,140 people have been vaccinated against COVID-19 as second doses and 62,377 people as first doses on 31 October.
- A total of 13,309 students aged 12 years and above from Basic Education Middle and High schools in respective regions and states have been vaccinated against COVID-19 on 31 October. A total of 984,609 students have been vaccinated against COVID-19 up to 31 October.
- A total of 184 markets and 92 private markets under Yangon City Development Council will be opened starting

from 1 November.

- The effective period of the directive on the temporary restriction of international commercial passenger flights to Myanmar has been extended up to 30 November 2021.

The Ministry of Health is conducting COVID-19 tests regularly, 752 new cases of COVID-19 were found from testing a total of 17,084 samples and the infected rates are 4.40 percent on 31 October. Up to 31 October 2021, a total of 500,073 cases were found from testing a total of 4,866,791 samples and death toll reached 18,697.

## OMNI FOCUS Company Denounced the Terrorists' Attacks Targeting against People

The terrorist groups CRPH, NUG and PDF are conducting all kinds of terror acts including violent killings, blowing up mines, arson attacks against non-military targets of civilians with an intent to disrupt the State's peace, stability and the rule of law.

On 31 October, a YBS bus was attacked by a PDF terrorist using a petrol-bomb near the Sim-malite bus-stop in Kyimyindine township of Yangon region leaving the bus burnt down and destroyed.

Regarding the above-mentioned incident, OMNI FOCUS the owner of the YBS routes released a statement via social media stating that 'The act of organizations under

the title of anti-government to attack the YBS route relied by public commuters its busiest and most crowded time is just a nefarious act in reality since it was a deliberated attack to kill and injure innocent people who are totally not related to the government and therefore, we totally denounce the nefarious act'

PDF terrorist groups had reportedly conducted bombings and arson attacks against the public transport routes before.

### Preparations are Underway to Reopen Schools

As the basic education schools were temporarily closed during the COVID-19 outbreak and now the infection rate has declined to a certain extent, the State Government will reopen the basic education school starting from 1 November not to delay an academic year of students. The Tatmadaw and departmental officials join hands together to make necessary preparations and clean up the school campus to ensure the peaceful learnings of students when the schools reopen.

In doing so, on 31 October, local Tatmadaw personnel from respective Regional Command, police force members and departmental officials conducted clean-

up activities in the campuses of 242 schools in total: 68 schools in 6 townships of Nay Pyi Taw Union Territory, 27 schools in 8 townships of Ayeyarwady region, 43 schools in 13 townships of Bago region, 54 schools in six townships of Tanintharyi region, 10 schools in six townships of Kachin state, 31 schools in 11 townships of Shan state and 9 schools in 3 townships of Kayin state. Their activities include cleaning the bushes in and outside of the school campuses; clearing the garbage, doing preparations for better drainage system and spraying disinfections against mosquitos.
